





## INTERACTIONS

**32%** of students wrote about interactions - talking with people, one-on-one contacts, face-to-face exchanges, socializing, and more. They wrote about interactions in general as well as interactions with specific people.

**“It’s small, but I miss walking to class everyday.** I miss saying hi to people I’d always see on the way. I miss the easiness of socializing with friends and favorite professors/faculty during and in between classes.”

“I miss being about to walk down the hallway and see my friends when I’m bored or sad and riding the train with them on weekends and playing board games with them.”



## CAMPUS FACILITIES AND SPACES

More than **10%** of students wrote about other aspects of campus including specific facilities (e.g., library, recreation center, specific buildings) and campus green spaces.

“I would spend everyday studying at the library on campus. I would meet in person with study groups on campus in the library especially after clinical.”

“While taking classes on campus, I had places to go where I knew when it was time to sit down and get to work. However **at home, it’s hard to create a space where I can do that.**”

“I miss how beautiful the campus always looks in Spring, with all the flowers blooming.”



## STUDENT ATHLETES

Student athletes wrote about missing their coaches, their teammates, practice and activity, as well as playing their sport.

“I’ll miss being able to see my friends and continuing my **last year of sports**”

“Not playing lacrosse and **being with the team.**”

“I miss athletics and my friends the most. I have missed getting to see my coaches and keep up my physical activity with my team members- and I greatly miss the seniors on our team.”



## GRADUATING STUDENTS

Graduating students wrote about the experiences they will miss and spoke to the unexpected nature of the disruption.

“I was greatly looking forward to the graduation ceremony. Being able to walk across the stage, having my family there, showing my kids how hard work leads to accomplishments, **proving to myself that “I am a college graduate.”**”

“I miss that I won’t get to walk for my graduation because of this and I didn’t get to say goodbye to my friends and thank you to my professors.”

“All the activities I will miss out on my senior year and all the friends I did not get to say goodbye to.”

The COVID-19 campus shut-downs were necessary and disruptive. Students wrote about a variety of topics when asked to describe what they will miss most about the on-campus, in-person experience this Spring. The themes, stories, and quotes describe not only how disruptive COVID-19 has been to their lives, but they also describe what students want, need, and value about the college experience.
